



**ROCKY MOUNTAIN YOUTH CORPS**  
**Military Veteran Fuels/Fire Engine Crew Member**

**Partner Agency:** US Forest Service – Yampa Ranger District

**Positions Available:** 4

**Location:** Yampa, CO

**Tentative Dates:** April 5th- October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021 with possibility of extension with USFS.

**Pay:** \$19/hour, boot allowance up to \$400, per Diem up to \$400  
Housing stipend of \$125/week for up to 27 weeks.

**Program Overview:**

This position will be working as a member of a four-person U.S. Military Veteran fuels reduction crew hosted and supervised by the Medicine/Bow Routt National Forests at the Yampa Ranger District. Primary duties will include operating a chainsaw, stacking cut material into piles, hiking over uneven terrain, and camping overnight on national forest land. Crew members will be trained in the use of chainsaws and wildland firefighting, previous experience is preferred but not required. The successful applicant must have a strong work ethic, positive attitude, and a willingness to learn. The Forest Service will provide all supplies and equipment needed to perform the job. Applicant will need to purchase minimum 8" high, lace-type exterior leather work boots with lug melt-resistant soles. \$400 boot allowance is provided by RMYC.

Throughout the season there will be opportunities to work on prescribed burns and wildland fire assignments. While on fires the incumbent will switch from RMYC's payroll to being paid directly by the agency in charge of the fire (AD status). This provides opportunity for overtime and hazard pay.

Housing stipend will be paid when logging hours with RMYC. When on prescribed burns or wildfires and on AD status housing stipend will not be paid.

**General Qualifications:**

- Applicant must be able to perform arduous labor in remote locations for 10-12 hours per day.
- Ability to pass USFS Work Capacity Test at the "arduous" level (3-mile walk on flat ground with 45-pound pack in 46 minutes) <https://www.fs.usda.gov/managing-land/fire/safety/wct>. This is required for the opportunity to work on wildland fires.
- Willingness to travel.

**Requirements:**

- US Military Post-9/11 Veterans
- DD214 form showing Honorable Discharge or General Discharge (under Honorable Conditions)
- Valid driver's license
- Pre-service background screening required including FBI background check.
- High School Diploma or Higher
- U.S. Citizenship or permission to work in the US
- Position supported by the Public Lands Hiring Authority requiring candidates to be between the ages of 16 to 35.

*This position is classified as Temporary Regular Non-Exempt and is a seasonal position with no benefits.*
